- 11 SECTION 2. Section 2154.201(a), Occupations Code, is

- 13 (a) [A person who is younger than 21 years of age may not be
- 14 issued a public fireworks display permit. A person who is younger
- 15 than 18 years of age may not be issued  $\underline{a}$  [another] permit under this
- 16 subchapter.
