Subchapter A, Chapter 61, Election Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 61.015 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 61.015. WATER ALLOCATION TO VOTERS NEAR POLLING PLACE. 7 (a) A person may distribute water to voters waiting in line at a polling place, if: 8 9 (1) the water: (A) is provided in a single use, sealed 10 11 container; and 12 (B) does not contain any branding, logos, or 13 messaging related to a campaign, measure, or political party; and (2) the dist<u>ribution of the water:</u> 14 15 (A) is conducted in a nonpartisan manner; and 16 (B) does not obstruct or interfere with the 17 voting process. 18 (b) A person distributing water under this section may not wear attire or display materials that represent a campaign, 19 20 measure, or political party. 21 (c) Election officials shall ensure that any person 22 distributing water at a polling place complies with this section. 23 The election official may remove a person found in violation of this 24 section from the polling place.
