6	Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
8	the court that rendered a final decree of divorce or annulment or
9	another final order dividing property under this title retains
10	continuing, exclusive jurisdiction to render an order under this
11	subchapter to divide property not divided or awarded to a spouse in
12	the final decree.
13	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
14	suit to divide property not divided or awarded to a spouse in a
15	final decree of divorce or annulment that is pending in a trial
16	court on the effective date of this Act or that is filed on or after
17	that date.
18	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
