- 2 relating to tuition and fee exemptions at public institutions of
- 3 higher education for certain peace officers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.3531, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (e) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) The governing board of an institution of higher
- 9 education shall exempt from the payment of tuition and laboratory
- 10 fees charged by the institution for a [criminal justice or law
- 11 enforcement] course or courses a [an undergraduate] student who:
- 12 (1) is employed as a peace officer by this state or by
- 13 a political subdivision of this state;
- 14 (2) is enrolled in a [criminal justice or] law
- 15 enforcement-related degree program at the institution;
- 16 (3) is making satisfactory academic progress toward
- 17 the student's degree as determined by the institution; and
- 18 (4) applies for the exemption at least one week before
- 19 the last date of the institution's regular registration period for
- 20 the applicable semester or other term.
- 21 (a-1) The Texas Commission on Law Enforcement, in
- 22 consultation with the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board,
- 23 shall adopt rules specifying which degree programs are law
- 24 enforcement-related for purposes of Subsection (a)(2).

- 1 (e) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 2 adopt[+
- 3 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ rules governing the granting or denial of an
- 4 exemption under this section, including rules relating to the
- 5 determination of a student's eligibility for an exemption[; and
- 6 [(2) a uniform listing of degree programs covered by the
- 7 exemption under this section].
- 8 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 9 of this Act, the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement shall adopt the
- 10 rules required by Section 54.3531(a-1), Education Code, as added by
- 11 this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 54.3531, Education Code, as amended by
- 13 this Act, applies beginning with tuition and other fees charged for
- 14 the 2025 fall semester. Tuition and other fees charged for an
- 15 academic period before that semester are governed by the law in
- 16 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 17 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
