- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.102, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 54.102. QUALIFICATIONS FOR DIRECTORS. To be qualified
- 8 to serve as a director, a person shall:
- 9 <u>(1)</u> be at least 18 years old;
- 10 (2) be $[\tau]$ a resident citizen of the State of Texas; $[\tau]$
- 11 and
- 12 (3) either own land subject to taxation in the
- 13 district or be a qualified voter within the district.
- 14 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 54, Water Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Section 54.103 to read as follows:
- Sec. 54.103. QUALIFICATIONS FOR DIRECTORS IN CERTAIN
- 17 COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a district wholly or
- 18 partly located in a county that:
- 19 <u>(1) borders the United Mexican States; and</u>
- 20 (2) contains a municipality with a population of more
- 21 than 500,000.
- (b) Notwithstanding Section 54.102, to be qualified to
- 23 serve as a director of a district to which this section applies, a
- 24 person shall:

1 (1) meet the requirements of Sections 54.102(1) and

2 (2); and

3 (2) be a qualified voter within the district.

4 SECTION 3. Section 54.103, Water Code, as added by this Act, does not affect the entitlement of a member serving immediately 5 before the effective date of this Act on the board of directors of a 6 municipal utility district described by that section to continue to 7 8 carry out the board's functions for the remainder of the member's That section applies only to a member of the board of directors of such a district elected or appointed on or after the 10 effective date of this Act. That section does not prohibit a person 11 who is a member of the board of directors of such a district on the 12 effective date of this Act from being reelected or reappointed to 13 14 the board if the person has the qualifications required for a member 15 under that section.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
