- 5 SECTION 1. Section 285.001(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) To promote the public safety, the commissioners court of
- 8 a county with a population of more than 1.3 million and a county
- 9 with a population of more than 600,000 that is adjacent to a county
- 10 with a population of more than four million by order may regulate
- 11 the following in the unincorporated area of the county if they occur
- 12 on a public highway or road, in the right-of-way of a public highway
- 13 or road, or in a parking lot:
- 14 (1) the sale of items by a vendor of food or
- 15 merchandise, including live animals;
- 16 (2) the erection, maintenance, or placement of a
- 17 structure by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live
- 18 animals; and
- 19 (3) the solicitation of money.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
