## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to regulation by certain counties of roadside or parking 3 lot vendors and solicitors. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 285.001(a), Transportation Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 (a) To promote the public safety, the commissioners court of 7 a county with a population of more than 1.3 million and a county 8 with a population of more than 600,000 that is adjacent to a county 9 with a population of more than four million by order may regulate 10 11 the following in the unincorporated area of the county if they occur 12 on a public highway or road, in the right-of-way of a public highway or road, or in a parking lot: 13 14 (1) the sale of items by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live animals; 15 (2) the erection, maintenance, or placement of a 16 structure by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live 17 animals; and 18 (3) the solicitation of money. 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 20
