## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of the Brazoria County Commissioners

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 5002.203, Special District Local Laws

7 Code, is amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 5002.203. DESIGNATION OF REINVESTMENT ZONE. (a)

9 Notwithstanding Subchapters B and C, Chapter 312, Tax Code, the

district may submit a written request to the commissioners court of

11 a county in which a property owned by the district is located for

12 the commissioners court to designate the property as a reinvestment

13 zone [or area] for the purposes of Chapter 312, Tax Code. The

14 commissioners court may designate the property as a reinvestment

15 zone [or area] if the commissioners court finds the criteria set

16 forth in Section 312.202, Tax Code, are met for the property as if a

17 municipality in which the property is located were creating the

18 zone.

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19 <u>(b) The commissioners court may execute a tax abatement</u>

20 agreement with the owner of a leasehold interest in tax-exempt real

21 property or property owned by the district located in a

22 reinvestment zone designated under this subchapter to exempt all or

23 <u>a portion of the value of the leasehold interest in the real</u>

24 property. The court may execute a tax abatement agreement with the

- 1 owners of tangible personal property or an improvement located on
- 2 tax-exempt real property or property owned by the district that is
- 3 <u>located in a reinvestment zone designated under this subchapter to</u>
- 4 exempt all or a portion of the value of the tangible personal
- 5 property or improvement located on the real property.
- 6 (c) The other terms of an agreement entered into under this
- 7 <u>section are governed by Chapter 312, Tax Code.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
