1-19 relating to vehicle safety inspections of certain travel trailers.
1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-21 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 548.510, Transportation
1-22 Code, as amended by Chapters 851 (H.B. 3297) and 999 (H.B. 198),
1-23 Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, is reenacted
1-24 to read as follows:
1-25 Sec. 548.510. INSPECTION PROGRAM REPLACEMENT FEE.
1-26 SECTION 2. Section 548.510(a), Transportation Code, as
1-27 amended by Chapters 851 (H.B. 3297) and 999 (H.B. 198), Acts of the
1-28 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, is reenacted to read as
1-29 follows:
1-30 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b) and (c), in
1-31 addition to other fees imposed at the time of registration, at the
1-32 time of application for initial registration or renewal of
1-33 registration of a motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, pole
1-34 trailer, or mobile home, the applicant shall pay an annual fee of
1-35 \$7.50.
1-36 SECTION 3. Section 548.054, Transportation Code, is
1-37 repealed.
1-38 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
