4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 45, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 45.114 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 45.114. BOND, TAX, AND PROJECT DATABASE. (a) In this
8	section:
9	(1) "Bond" means a bond described by Section 45.001.
10	(2) "Database" means the database established under
11	this section.
12	(3) "Maintenance tax" means a tax described by Section
13	45.002.
14	(b) The agency shall develop and maintain a database that
15	includes current information regarding school district bonds,
16	taxes, and bond-related projects, including:
17	(1) for each bond issued or proposed by a school
18	<u>district:</u>
19	(A) the language of the ballot proposition under
20	Section 45.003(b);
21	(B) the projected interest and sinking fund tax
22	rate associated with a proposed bond;
23	(C) the result of an election held for the
24	purpose of issuing a proposed bond;

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1	(D) a list of the projects to be funded using the
2	bond;
3	(E) an accounting of the use of the proceeds of
4	any issued bond, including descriptions of any projects paid for
5	with the proceeds; and
6	(F) any increase in the interest and sinking fund
7	tax rate resulting from issued bonds;
8	(2) for maintenance taxes that have been levied or
9	proposed by a school district:
10	(A) each school district's proposed or approved
11	tax rate; and
12	(B) the language of the ballot proposition under
13	Section 45.003(d);
14	(3) the results of any election held under Section
15	26.08, Tax Code, including the ad valorem tax rate proposed by the
16	school district for purposes of the election;
17	(4) a report generation function to allow the agency
18	to generate reports of the information described by Subdivisions
19	(1) and (2) for each school district, disaggregated by geographic
20	area; and
21	(5) a function that allows for the proposal of updates
22	or corrections to the information included in the database.
23	(c) A school district shall provide the agency with the
24	information described by Subsections (b)(1) through (3) and any
25	other information requested by the agency for the purpose of
26	maintaining the database established under this section.
27	(d) The agency may contract with a third party as necessary

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1 for the development or maintenance of the database under this
2 section.

3 (e) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to 4 implement this section.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
