- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2007.002, Insurance Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2007.002. ASSESSMENT. The comptroller shall assess
- 9 against all insurers to which this chapter applies amounts for each
- 10 state fiscal year necessary, as determined by the commissioner, to
- 11 collect [a combined total equal to the lesser of:
- 12  $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$  the total amount that the General Appropriations
- 13 Act appropriates from the volunteer fire department assistance fund
- 14 account in the general revenue fund for that state fiscal year,
- 15 other than appropriations for contributions to the Texas Emergency
- 16 Services Retirement System made under Section 614.104(d),
- 17 Government Code[+ or
- $[\frac{(2) \quad \$30 \text{ million}}{}].$
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 614.102, Government Code, is amended by
- 20 adding Subsections (i) and (j) to read as follows:
- 21 <u>(i) At least 10 percent of appropriations for a state fiscal</u>
- 22 year from the fund is allocated for the purpose of providing
- 23 <u>assistance to volunteer fire departments in areas of the state</u>
- 24 defined by the service as high risk for large wildfires.

- 1 (j) If the amount of assistance requested in a state fiscal
- 2 year by eligible departments described by Subsection (i) is less
- 3 than the amount allocated under that subsection, the remaining
- 4 amount may be used for other types of requests for assistance
- 5 <u>described by this subchapter.</u>
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
