- committee shall annually, using data from the preceding year: 8

- (A) cases of pregnancy-related deaths; 10
- 11 (B) trends, rates, and [or] disparities
- 12 pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity;
- conditions 13 (C) health and factors that
- 14 disproportionately affect the most at-risk population as
- determined in the joint biennial report required under Section 15
- 16 34.015; and
- (D) best practices and programs operating in 17
- other states that have reduced rates of pregnancy-related deaths; 18
- (2) compare rates of pregnancy-related deaths based on 19
- the socioeconomic status of the mother; 20
- (3) determine the feasibility of the review committee 21
- 22 studying cases of severe maternal morbidity; and
- 23 (4) in consultation with the Perinatal Advisory
- 24 Council, make recommendations to help reduce the incidence of

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- 1 pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity in this
- 2 state.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
