A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to a study of rural firefighting and technical rescue 1-19 1-20 service capabilities. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. STUDY ON RURAL FIREFIGHTING AND TECHNICAL RESCUE SERVICE CAPABILITIES. (a) In this Act, "service" means the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service. 1-24

1-25 (b) The service shall conduct a study of rural firefighting 1-26 technical rescue service capabilities and compare those and 1-27 capabilities with those of urban municipalities. The study must 1-28 consider disparities in: 1-29

available funding for personnel and equipment; (1)

1-30 (2) the number of qualified candidates to fill new or 1-31 vacant firefighting and rescue personnel positions;

for 1-32 (3) opportunities affordable for training 1-33 firefighting and rescue personnel; and 1-34

(4) any other factor the service considers relevant.

SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2026, the 1-35 service shall submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives a report that includes the findings of the study and any recommendations based on the 1-36 1-37 1-38 1-39 study. 1-40

SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. This Act expires September 1, 2027.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 1-41 1-42 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 1-43 1 - 44Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 1-45 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
