

H.B. No. 2198

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 34 in
3 Kaufman County as the Officer Jacob Candanoza Memorial Highway.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
6 is amended by adding Section 225.249 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 225.249. OFFICER JACOB CANDANOZA MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

8 (a) The portion of State Highway 34 in Kaufman County between its
9 intersection with Kings Creek Drive and its intersection with North
10 Frances Street is designated as the Officer Jacob Candanoza
11 Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other
12 designation.

(b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

19 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the 89th Legislature,
20 Regular Session, 2025, that the provisions added by this Act be
21 renumbered to prevent multiple provisions with the same
22 designation.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
