A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT 2 relating to developing a strategic plan for the improvement and 3 expansion of early learning and educational opportunities for young 4 children with disabilities. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 29.0091 to read as follows:

8 <u>Sec. 29.0091. STRATEGIC PLAN TO IMPROVE AND EXPAND EARLY</u> 9 <u>LEARNING AND EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG CHILDREN WITH</u> 10 <u>DISABILITIES. (a) The agency, in collaboration with the Health and</u> 11 <u>Human Services Commission and the Texas Workforce Commission, shall</u> 12 <u>develop and implement a strategic plan to improve early learning</u> 13 <u>and educational opportunities for young children with disabilities</u> 14 <u>or developmental delays.</u>

15 (b) In developing the strategic plan, the agency, in 16 coordination with the Health and Human Services Commission and the 17 <u>Texas Workforce Commission, shall:</u>

18 (1) develop strategies for the inclusion of children 19 with disabilities in early childhood education settings;

20 (2) consider topics and existing barriers relating to 21 ensuring, and any changes to existing practices or policies 22 necessary to ensure, more effective inclusion of children with 23 disabilities in early learning programs, including in:

24 (A) prekindergarten programs under Subchapter E,

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1	including prekindergarten programs provided under a partnership
2	between school districts and community-based child-care providers;
3	(B) early childhood special education settings;
4	and
5	(C) child-care programs participating in the
6	Texas Workforce Commission's subsidized child-care program; and
7	(3) coordinate with, at a minimum, representatives of
8	state, regional, and local agencies, the governor's Texas Early
9	Learning Council, nonprofit organizations, and relevant social
10	services providers.
11	(c) The strategic plan must include:
12	(1) the strategies for the inclusion of children with
13	disabilities in early childhood education settings developed under
14	Subsection (b)(1) signed by the commissioner, the executive
15	commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission, and the
16	executive director of the Texas Workforce Commission;
17	(2) a description of existing barriers to the
18	effective inclusion of children with disabilities in early learning
19	programs;
20	(3) recommendations for statutory, regulatory,
21	guidance, or funding changes, and policy implementation changes,
22	necessary to improve the inclusion of young children with
23	disabilities in early childhood education programs; and
24	(4) current and proposed strategies and
25	recommendations to achieve:
26	(A) improved provider staffing, training,
27	sustainability, and effectiveness across public schools,

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1	child-care programs, and early childhood intervention services
2	providers that serve young children with disabilities;
3	(B) the effective leveraging of existing funding
4	and resources;
5	(C) streamlined transitions for families:
6	(i) from early childhood intervention
7	programs to early childhood special education programs; and
8	(ii) from early childhood special education
9	programs to special education programs; and
10	(D) improved collaboration and partnerships
11	between child-care programs, early childhood intervention services
12	providers, and public schools.
13	(d) Not later than September 1 of the last state fiscal year
14	in each four-year period covered by the most recent strategic plan:
15	(1) the agency shall update the strategic plan for the
16	<pre>subsequent four-year period;</pre>
17	(2) the agency shall submit the updated strategic plan
18	developed under Subdivision (1) to the governor, the lieutenant
19	governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives; and
20	(3) the agency, the Health and Human Services
21	Commission, and the Texas Workforce Commission shall publish the
22	updated strategic plan developed under Subdivision (1) on the
23	agencies' respective Internet websites.
24	SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2026:
25	(1) the Texas Education Agency, the Health and Human
26	Services Commission, and the Texas Workforce Commission shall
27	publish the initial strategic plan required by Section 29.0091,

H.B. No. 2310 1 Education Code, as added by this Act, on the agencies' respective 2 Internet websites; and

3 (2) the Texas Education Agency shall submit the 4 initial strategic plan described by Subdivision (1) of this section 5 to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the 6 house of representatives.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
