- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 6.052, Water Code, is
- amended to read as follows: 7

as follows:

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- Sec. 6.052. MEMBERS OF THE BOARD; ELECTION [APPOINTMENT]. 8
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 6.052(a), Water Code, is amended to read
- $[\frac{a}{a}]$ The board is composed of 16 $[\frac{b}{a}]$ members who are 11
- 12 elected by the qualified voters of the regional water planning area
- in which the member is running on the uniform election date in 13
- 14 November authorized by Section 41.001, Election Code [appointed by
- the governor with the advice and consent of the senate. One member 15
- 16 must have experience in the field of engineering, one member must
- have experience in the field of public or private finance, and one 17
- member must have experience in the field of law or business]. 18
- SECTION 3. Sections 6.053(a), (b), and (d), Water Code, are 19
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 Members of the board must be members of the general
- public who have experience in the fields of engineering, public or 22
- 23 private finance, or law or business.
- 24 A person is not eligible for election [appointment] to (b)

- 1 the board if the person or the person's spouse:
- 2 (1) is employed by or participates in the management
- 3 of a business entity or other organization regulated by the board or
- 4 receiving funds from the board;
- 5 (2) owns, controls, or has, directly or indirectly,
- 6 more than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other
- 7 organization regulated by the board or receiving funds from the
- 8 board; or
- 9 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 10 goods, services, or funds from the board.
- 11 (d) A person is not eligible for <u>election</u> [appointment] to
- 12 the board if the person served on the board on or before January 1,
- 13 2013.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 6.054(a), Water Code, is amended to read
- 15 as follows:
- 16 (a) It is a ground for removal from the board that a member:
- 17 (1) does not have at the time of taking office the
- 18 qualifications required for election [appointment] to the board;
- 19 (2) does not maintain during service on the board the
- 20 qualifications required for election [appointment] to the board;
- 21 (3) is ineligible for membership under Sections 6.053,
- 22 6.057, and 6.058;
- 23 (4) cannot, because of illness or disability,
- 24 discharge the member's duties for a substantial part of the member's
- 25 term; or
- 26 (5) is absent from more than half of the regularly
- 27 scheduled board meetings that the member is eligible to attend

- 1 during a calendar year without an excuse approved by a majority vote
- 2 of the board.
- 3 SECTION 5. Section 6.056, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 Sec. 6.056. TERMS OF OFFICE. (a) The members of the board
- 6 hold office for staggered terms of six years[, with the term of one
- 7 member expiring February 1 of each odd-numbered year]. Each member
- 8 holds office until a successor is <u>elected</u> [appointed] and has
- 9 qualified.
- 10 (b) A person <u>elected</u> [appointed] to the board may not serve
- 11 for more than two six-year terms.
- 12 SECTION 6. Section 6.059, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 13 follows:
- Sec. 6.059. CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD. The members of the board
- 15 [governor] shall elect [designate] one member as chairman of the
- 16 board [to serve at the will of the governor].
- SECTION 7. Sections 6.062(a) and (c), Water Code, are
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) A person who is elected [appointed] to and qualifies for
- 20 office as a member of the board may not vote, deliberate, or be
- 21 counted as a member in attendance at a meeting of the board until
- 22 the person completes a training program that complies with this
- 23 section.
- (c) A person elected [appointed] to the board is entitled to
- 25 reimbursement, as provided by the General Appropriations Act, for
- 26 the travel expenses incurred in attending the training program
- 27 regardless of whether the attendance at the program occurs before

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- 1 or after the person qualifies for office.
- 2 SECTION 8. Sections 6.052(b) and (c), Water Code, are
- 3 repealed.
- 4 SECTION 9. (a) The Texas Water Development Board shall hold
- 5 an election to elect 16 directors as described by Section 6.052,
- 6 Water Code, as amended by this Act, on the uniform election date in
- 7 November 2026.
- 8 (b) At the first meeting of the members of the Texas Water
- 9 Development Board that follows the election of members under
- 10 Subsection (a) of this section, the members shall draw lots to
- 11 determine which four directors shall serve a term of two years,
- 12 which six directors shall serve a term of four years, and which six
- 13 directors shall serve a term of six years. Thereafter, all elected
- 14 members serve six-year terms.
- 15 (c) The terms of the members serving on the Texas Water
- 16 Development Board expire on the date the members elected under
- 17 Subsection (a) of this section have qualified.
- 18 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025, but
- 19 only if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 89th
- 20 Legislature, Regular Session, 2025, requiring the board members of
- 21 the Texas Water Development Board to be elected by the qualified
- 22 voters at a general election instead of appointed by the governor is
- 23 approved by the voters. If that amendment is not approved by the
- 24 voters, this Act has no effect.
