- (1) uses a motor vehicle, aircraft, watercraft, or 7
- other means of conveyance to transport an individual with the 8

- (A) conceal the individual from a peace officer 10
- 11 or special investigator; or
- 12 (B) flee from a person the actor knows is a peace
- 13 officer or special investigator attempting to lawfully arrest or
- 14 detain the actor;
- (2) encourages or induces a person to enter or remain 15
- 16 in this country in violation of state or federal law [by concealing,
- harboring, or shielding that person from detection]; or 17
- 18 (3) assists, guides, or directs two or more
- individuals to enter or remain on agricultural land without the 19
- effective consent of the owner. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 23
- governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 24

- 2 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 3 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
