5	SECTION 1. Chapter 562, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER C. WATER CONSERVATION
8	Sec. 562.051. WATER CONSERVATION PROGRAMS FOR CERTAIN
9	COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a county that has a
10	population greater than 230,000, is wholly or partly located within
11	the boundaries of the Hill Country Priority Groundwater Management
12	Area, and is adjacent to a county with a population greater than one
13	million.
14	(b) The commissioners court of a county by order may adopt a
15	water conservation program. Except as provided by Subsection (c),
16	a water conservation program adopted under this section may
17	establish for the unincorporated area of the county, including the
18	extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, water
19	conservation standards applicable to a development, redevelopment,
20	or subdivision of a tract of land that begins after August 31, 2025.
21	(c) Water conservation standards established under
22	Subsection (b) apply only to water used for landscaping on a tract
23	of land being developed, redeveloped, or subdivided for residential
24	development.
