4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Article 14.03(g), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended by adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows:
7	(2-a) A peace officer described by Article 2A.001(14)
8	who is licensed under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, and is
9	outside of the officer's jurisdiction may arrest without a warrant
10	a person who commits any offense within the officer's presence or
11	view, except that an officer described in this subdivision who is
12	outside of that officer's jurisdiction may arrest a person for a
13	violation of Subtitle C, Title 7, Transportation Code, only if the
14	offense is committed in a county with a population of 500,000 or
15	more in which the district employing the peace officer is located.
16	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
