Article 14.03(g), Code of Criminal Procedure, is 5 amended by adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows: 6 7 (2-a) A peace officer described by Article 2A.001(14) who is licensed under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, and is 8 9 outside of the officer's jurisdiction may arrest without a warrant a person who commits any offense within the officer's presence or 10 11 view, except that an officer described in this subdivision who is 12 outside of that officer's jurisdiction may arrest a person for a violation of Subtitle C, Title 7, Transportation Code, only if the 13 14 offense is committed in a county with a population of 500,000 or more in which the district employing the peace officer is located. 15 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
