- 6 SECTION 3. (a) Section 37.0095, Education Code, as added by
- 7 this Act, applies beginning with the 2025-2026 school year.
- 8 (b) Section 51.9791, Education Code, as added by this Act,
- 9 applies beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
