2 relating to the jurisdiction of the county courts at law in Hidalgo

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 25.1102(a), Government Code, is amended

6 to read as follows:

- 7 (a) In addition to the jurisdiction provided by Section
- 8 25.0003 and other law, a county court at law in Hidalgo County has
- 9 concurrent jurisdiction with the district court in:
- 10 (1) family law cases and proceedings; [and]
- 11 (2) civil cases; and
- 12 (3) criminal cases for an offense punishable as a
- 13 state jail felony [in which the matter in controversy does not
- 14 exceed \$750,000, excluding interest, statutory or punitive damages
- 15 and penalties, and attorney's fees and costs, as alleged on the page
- 16 of the petition].
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 25.1102(a), Government Code, as amended
- 18 by this Act, applies only to an action filed in a county court at law
- 19 in Hidalgo County on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 20 action filed in a county court at law in Hidalgo County before the
- 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 22 date the action was filed, and the former law is continued in effect
- 23 for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
