1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to increasing the criminal penalty for the failure of  
1-18 certain sex offenders to comply with sex offender registration  
1-19 requirements.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Articles 62.102(c) and (d), Code of Criminal  
1-22 Procedure, are amended to read as follows:

1-23 (c) If it is shown at the trial of a person for an offense or  
1-24 an attempt to commit an offense under this article that the person  
1-25 has previously been convicted of an offense or an attempt to commit  
1-26 an offense under this article, the ~~[punishment for the]~~ offense or  
1-27 the attempt to commit the offense is increased to the ~~[punishment~~  
1-28 ~~for the]~~ next highest category of offense ~~[degree of felony]~~.

1-29 (d) If it is shown at the trial of a person for an offense  
1-30 under this article or an attempt to commit an offense under this  
1-31 article that the person fraudulently used identifying information  
1-32 in violation of Section 32.51, Penal Code, during the commission or  
1-33 attempted commission of the offense, the ~~[punishment for the]~~  
1-34 offense or the attempt to commit the offense is increased to ~~[the~~  
1-35 ~~punishment for]~~ the next highest category of offense ~~[degree of~~  
1-36 ~~felony]~~.

1-37 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
1-38 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.  
1-39 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is  
1-40 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,  
1-41 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For  
1-42 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the  
1-43 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was  
1-44 committed before that date.

1-45 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
