6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 225.250 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 225.250. SENIOR POLICE OFFICER LEWIS "ANDY" TRAYLOR
9	MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of Farm-to-Market Road 969 in
10	Travis County between its intersection with Decker Lane and its
11	intersection with U.S. Highway 183 is designated as the Senior
12	Police Officer Lewis "Andy" Traylor Memorial Highway. The
13	designation is in addition to any other designation.
14	(b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:
15	(1) design and construct markers indicating the
16	designation as the Senior Police Officer Lewis "Andy" Traylor
17	Memorial Highway and any other appropriate information; and
18	(2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
19	appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.
20	SECTION 2. It is the intent of the 89th Legislature, Regular
21	Session, 2025, that the provisions added by this Act be renumbered
22	to prevent multiple provisions with the same designation.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
