A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the authority of the Railroad Commission of Texas and
- 3 the Public Utility Commission of Texas to address a failure by an
- 4 operator to maintain an electrical power line serving a well site or
- 5 certain surface facilities in accordance with the National
- 6 Electrical Code.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 91.019, Natural Resources Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 91.019. STANDARDS FOR CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND
- 11 MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICAL POWER LINES. (a) An operator shall
- 12 construct, operate, and maintain an electrical power line serving a
- 13 well site or other surface facility employed in operations incident
- 14 to oil and gas development and production in accordance with the
- 15 National Electrical Code published by the National Fire Protection
- 16 Association and adopted by the Texas Commission of Licensing and
- 17 Regulation under Chapter 1305, Occupations Code.
- 18 (b) If, during an inspection of a well site or surface
- 19 facility employed in operations incident to oil and gas development
- 20 and production, the commission discovers a condition involving an
- 21 electrical power line that does not meet the standards described by
- 22 <u>Subsection (a), the commission shall notify the Public Utility</u>
- 23 Commission of Texas. To resolve the condition, the commission and
- 24 the Public Utility Commission of Texas, in collaboration, shall:

- 1 (1) notify the applicable electric utility providing
- 2 electric power to the well site or surface facility of the condition
- 3 and require the electric utility to make a determination regarding
- 4 whether electric power should be disconnected from the site or
- 5 facility;
- 6 (2) request that the state fire marshal or a local
- 7 government authority inspect the well site or surface facility and
- 8 require the operator to mitigate any dangerous conditions
- 9 identified by the state fire marshal or local government authority;
- 10 <u>or</u>
- 11 (3) issue notice to the applicable electric utility to
- 12 investigate the condition and disconnect electric service, if
- 13 <u>necessary.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 91.019, Natural Resources Code, as
- 15 amended by this Act, applies to an inspection that occurs on or
- 16 after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
