- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1551.232 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1551.232. COVERAGE FOR DOULA SERVICES. (a) In this
- 8 section, "doula services" means nonmedical childbirth education,
- 9 <u>coaching</u>, and <u>support services</u>, <u>including</u> emotional and physical
- 10 support provided during pregnancy, labor, delivery, and the
- 11 postpartum period, or provided intermittently during pregnancy and
- 12 <u>the postpartum period.</u>
- 13 (b) A health benefit plan provided under the group benefits
- 14 program must provide coverage for doula services.
- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 1575, Insurance Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Section 1575.175 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 1575.175. COVERAGE FOR DOULA SERVICES. (a) In this
- 18 section, "doula services" means nonmedical childbirth education,
- 19 coaching, and support services, including emotional and physical
- 20 support provided during pregnancy, labor, delivery, and the
- 21 postpartum period, or provided intermittently during pregnancy and
- 22 the postpartum period.
- 23 (b) A basic plan provided under the group program must
- 24 provide coverage for doula services.

- 11 SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 1601, Insurance Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Section 1601.112 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 1601.112. COVERAGE FOR DOULA SERVICES. (a) In this
- 14 section, "doula services" means nonmedical childbirth education,
- 15 coaching, and support services, including emotional and physical
- 16 support provided during pregnancy, labor, delivery, and the
- 17 postpartum period, or provided intermittently during pregnancy and
- 18 the postpartum period.
- 19 (b) A health benefit plan provided under this chapter must
- 20 provide coverage for doula services.
- 21 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 a plan year that commences on or after January 1, 2026.
- 23 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
