## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to conducting certain contested case hearings under the

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 410, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 410.0055 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 410.0055. CONDUCTING CERTAIN CONTESTED CASE HEARINGS
- 8 BY REMOTE COMMUNICATION. (a) Notwithstanding Section 410.005(a),
- 9 the division may conduct a contested case hearing by
- 10 videoconference:
- 11 (1) on a determination by the division that good cause
- 12 exists for conducting the hearing in that manner; or
- 13 (2) on the mutual agreement of the parties.
- 14 (b) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 15 implement this section.
- SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 17 of this Act, the commissioner of workers' compensation shall adopt
- 18 rules to implement Section 410.0055, Labor Code, as added by this
- 19 Act.
- SECTION 3. Section 410.0055, Labor Code, as added by this
- 21 Act, applies to a contested case hearing requested on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act. A contested case hearing requested
- 23 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 24 effect on the date the contested case hearing was requested, and the

- 1 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
