9	the division may conduct a contested case hearing by
10	<u>videoconference:</u>
11	(1) on a determination by the division that good cause
12	exists for conducting the hearing in that manner; or
13	(2) on the mutual agreement of the parties.
14	(b) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
15	implement this section.
16	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
17	of this Act, the commissioner of workers' compensation shall adopt
18	rules to implement Section 410.0055, Labor Code, as added by this
19	Act.
20	SECTION 3. Section 410.0055, Labor Code, as added by this
21	Act, applies to a contested case hearing requested on or after the
22	effective date of this Act. A contested case hearing requested
23	before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
24	effect on the date the contested case hearing was requested, and the

1 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
