## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the use of certain algorithmic devices in the
3	determination of residential rental prices.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Business & Commerce Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 121 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 121. ALGORITHMIC DEVICES USED TO DETERMINE RENT
8	Sec. 121.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Algorithmic device" means a device that uses one
10	or more algorithms to perform calculations of data. The term
11	includes a product that incorporates an algorithmic device. The
12	term does not include:
13	(A) a report published periodically and not more
14	frequently than monthly by a trade association that receives and
15	publishes data in an aggregated and anonymous manner; or
16	(B) a product used for the purpose of
17	establishing rent or income limits in accordance with the
18	affordable housing program guidelines of a political subdivision,
19	this state, or the federal government.
20	(2) "Nonpublic competitor data" means information
21	<pre>that:</pre>
22	(A) is not widely available or easily accessible
23	to the public, including information about actual rent prices,

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occupancy rates, and lease start and end dates, regardless of

- 1 whether the data is attributable to a specific competitor or
- 2 anonymized; and
- 3 (B) is derived from or otherwise provided to a
- 4 person by another person that competes in the same or a related
- 5 market.
- 6 Sec. 121.002. APPLICABILITY. (a) This chapter does not
- 7 apply to an algorithmic device that uses, incorporates, or was
- 8 trained with nonpublic competitor data if the data includes
- 9 nonpublic executed lease data that is also made available to the
- 10 public in an aggregated and anonymous manner at no more than a
- 11 reasonable charge.
- 12 (b) For purposes of this section, data made available to the
- 13 public in an aggregated and anonymous manner includes nonpublic
- 14 executed lease data tailored for the benefit of and usefulness to
- 15 consumers and presented as a range of average rent prices for
- 16 properties in a geographic area defined by its zip code,
- 17 neighborhood, geographical radius, or other type of apartment
- 18 industry submarket.
- 19 Sec. 121.003. CERTAIN ACTIONS RELATING TO ALGORITHMIC
- 20 DEVICES USED IN DETERMINING RESIDENTIAL RENT PROHIBITED. (a) The
- 21 sale of algorithmic device services or products for the purpose of
- 22 <u>setting or recommending the amount of rent to be charged to a tenant</u>
- 23 for residential premises is prohibited.
- 24 (b) A person engaged in the business of providing
- 25 algorithmic device services or products for the purpose of advising
- 26 a landlord of the amount of rent that the landlord may consider
- 27 charging a tenant for residential premises may not use nonpublic

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- 1 competitor data pertaining to residential properties in this state
- 2 <u>in algorithmic calculations.</u>
- 3 Sec. 121.004. DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE. A violation of
- 4 <u>Section 121.003</u> is a deceptive trade practice actionable under
- 5 <u>Subchapter E, Chapter 17.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
