H.B. No. 2512

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to release of an area from a municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction by petition or election.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 42.101, Local Government Code, is amended by amending Subdivisions (1), (4), and (5) and adding Subdivision (6) to read as follows:

(1) within [~~five~~] fifteen miles of the boundary of a military base, as defined by Section 43.0117, at which an active training program is conducted;

(4) in an area designated as an industrial district under Subsection 42.044; [~~or~~]

(5) in an area subject to a strategic partnership agreement entered into under Section 43.0751, or any other agreement, including a development agreement entered into under Section 212.172; or [-]

(6) in an area within a municipality's certificate of convenience and necessity issued in accordance with Chapter 13, Subchapter G, Water Code.

SECTION 2. Section 42.151, Local Government Code, is amended by amending Subdivisions (1), (4), and (5) and adding Subdivision (6) to read as follows:

(1) within [~~five~~] fifteen miles of the boundary of a military base, as defined by Section 43.0117, at which an active

11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
