3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 551.001(3), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(3) "Governmental body" means:
7	(A) a board, commission, department, committee,
8	or agency within the executive or legislative branch of state
9	government that is directed by one or more elected or appointed
10	members;
11	(B) a county commissioners court in the state;
12	(C) a municipal governing body in the state;
13	(D) a deliberative body that has rulemaking or
14	quasi-judicial power and that is classified as a department,
15	agency, or political subdivision of a county or municipality;
16	(E) a school district board of trustees;
17	(F) a county board of school trustees;
18	(G) a county board of education;
19	(H) the governing board of a special district
20	created by law;
21	(I) a local workforce development board created
22	under Section 2308.253;
23	(J) a nonprofit corporation that is eligible to
24	receive funds under the federal community services block grant

- 1 program and that is authorized by this state to serve a geographic
- 2 area of the state;
- 3 (K) a nonprofit corporation organized under
- 4 Chapter 67, Water Code, that provides a water supply or wastewater
- 5 service, or both, and is exempt from ad valorem taxation under
- 6 Section 11.30, Tax Code;
- 7 (L) a joint board created under Section 22.074,
- 8 Transportation Code; [and]
- 9 (M) a board of directors of a reinvestment zone
- 10 created under Chapter 311, Tax Code; and
- 11 (N) a board of managers appointed under Chapter
- 12 39A, Education Code.
- SECTION 2. Section 551.041, Government Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 551.041. NOTICE OF MEETING REQUIRED. (a) A
- 16 governmental body shall give written notice of the date, hour,
- 17 place, and subject of each meeting held by the governmental body.
- 18 (b) The notice must include an agenda for the meeting that
- 19 is the subject of the notice that:
- 20 (1) is sufficiently specific to inform the public of
- 21 each subject to be considered in the open portion of the meeting,
- 22 <u>including any matter:</u>
- 23 <u>(A) that is special or unusual; or</u>
- (B) in which the public may have a particular
- 25 <u>interest; and</u>
- 26 (2) describes any subject to be considered in the
- 27 closed portion of the meeting, if applicable.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 551.074, Government Code, is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 551.074. PERSONNEL MATTERS; CLOSED MEETING. (a) This
- 4 chapter does not require a governmental body to conduct an open
- 5 meeting:
- 6 (1) to deliberate the appointment, employment,
- 7 evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a
- 8 <u>specific</u> public officer or employee; or
- 9 (2) to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or
- 10 employee.
- 11 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply if:
- 12 (1) the officer or employee who is the subject of the
- 13 deliberation or hearing requests a public hearing; or
- 14 (2) the governmental body's deliberations under
- 15 Subsection (a)(1) concern operational issues that generally impact
- 16 <u>a class or group of employees</u>, including changes in the duties or
- 17 compensation of a class or group of employees.
- 18 SECTION 4. Section 551.083, Government Code, is repealed.
- 19 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 a meeting of a governmental body held on or after the effective date
- 21 of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
