TEMPORARY CERTIFIED AND INSURED PRESCRIBED BURN 7 8 MANAGER SELF-INSURANCE POOL Sec. 2155.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 9 (1) "CIPBM" means a person who is a certified and 10 insured prescribed burn manager under Section 153.048, Natural 11 12 Resources Code. 13 (2) "Fund" means the self-insurance fund established under Section 2155.006. 14 15 (3) "Program" means the CIPBM self-insurance program 16 administered under this chapter. (4) "Service" means the Texas A&M Forest Service. 17 18 Sec. 2155.002. CIPBM SELF-INSURANCE PROGRAM. (a) The service shall administer a CIPBM self-insurance program that: 19 (1) identifies and evaluates risks arising from 20 prescribed burns conducted under Chapter 153, Natural Resources 21 Cod<u>e;</u> 22 23 (2) maintains a loss-prevention and loss-control program to reduce risks arising from prescribed burns; 24

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1	(3) consolidates and administers prescribed burn risk
2	management and self-insurance programs; and
3	(4) provides prescribed burn self-insurance coverage
4	in accordance with Section 2155.003.
5	(b) The service may employ staff to administer the program.
6	(c) The director of the service may adopt rules to implement
7	and administer the program.
8	Sec. 2155.003. SELF-INSURANCE POOL; COVERAGE. (a) The
9	program shall administer a self-insurance pool to provide general
10	liability coverage for CIPBMs who are residents of this state.
11	(b) The coverage must indemnify a participating CIPBM for
12	liability arising from a prescribed burn. The coverage limits
13	provided must be the minimum amounts required for purposes of
14	Section 153.082, Natural Resources Code.
15	(c) The self-insurance pool may not provide coverage for a
16	risk other than prescribed burning conducted by a participating
17	CIPBM. Prohibited coverage includes:
18	(1) workers' compensation;
19	(2) automobile liability; and
20	(3) errors and omissions or professional liability.
21	(d) Self-insurance coverage provided under this section may
22	be funded only from money available from the fund.
23	(e) The director of the service may recommend:
24	(1) requirements for participation in coverage under
25	this section; and
26	(2) equipment and safety standards for the prescribed
27	burns to be covered under this section.

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1	Sec. 2155.004. PARTICIPATION IN SELF-INSURANCE POOL. (a)
2	To participate in coverage provided under Section 2155.003, a CIPBM
3	must submit a written request to the program in the form and manner
4	prescribed by the service.
5	(b) The director of the service shall approve the request
6	for participation if the CIPBM to be covered is certified under
7	Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code.
8	Sec. 2155.005. TRAINING REQUIREMENTS. (a) As a condition
9	for continuing participation in coverage provided under Section
10	2155.003, a participating CIPBM shall complete a wildfire
11	suppression course offered or sanctioned by the service that trains
12	the CIPBM on:
13	(1) proper coordination with this state or local fire
14	departments in the event that a prescribed burn escapes its
15	predetermined boundaries; and
16	(2) proper assistance in the suppression of a
17	naturally occurring wildfire.
18	(b) The service shall:
19	(1) develop the course described by Subsection (a) in
20	compliance with the minimum standards for prescribed burn manager
21	certification under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code; and
22	(2) maintain records of a participating CIPBM's
23	completion of the course.
24	Sec. 2155.006. TEMPORARY CIPBM SELF-INSURANCE FUND. (a)
25	The fund is an account in a depository selected by the board of
26	regents of The Texas A&M University System in the manner provided by
27	Section 51.003, Education Code, for funds subject to the control of

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1	institutions of higher education under Section 51.002, Education
2	<u>Code.</u>
3	(b) The fund is composed of:
4	(1) an amount not to exceed \$25 million appropriated
5	by the legislature;
6	(2) money collected under Section 2155.008; and
7	(3) interest accruing on money in the fund.
8	(c) Money in the fund may be spent only for:
9	(1) funding self-insurance under the program; or
10	(2) administering this chapter, including paying the
11	salaries and expenses of staff for the program and the fund.
12	Sec. 2155.007. LIMITATION ON STATE'S LIABILITY. The
13	state's liability for all losses covered by self-insurance provided
14	under this chapter is limited to the assets of the fund, and the
15	state is not otherwise liable for those losses.
16	Sec. 2155.008. SELF-INSURANCE FEE; COST-SHARING
17	REQUIREMENTS. (a) The service may assess and collect a reasonable
18	fee from participating CIPBMs to provide self-insurance coverage
19	under this chapter. The service shall also establish reasonable
20	cost-sharing requirements, including appropriate deductibles.
21	(b) In establishing the amount of the fee and the
22	cost-sharing requirements, the service shall consider the amount
23	that could be charged to the CIPBM for similar insurance coverage
24	provided to that CIPBM in accordance with this code and ensure that
25	a deductible is sufficiently high to:
26	(1) deter the use of the self-insurance coverage for
27	minor losses; and

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1	(2) ensure the self-insurance coverage is used only
2	for significant losses.
3	(c) The service shall adjust the amount of a premium for the
4	self-insurance coverage under this chapter by using the information
5	collected under Section 2155.009.
6	(d) Money collected under this section shall be deposited to
7	the credit of the fund.
8	Sec. 2155.009. PRESCRIBED BURN DATA COLLECTION. A
9	participating CIPBM shall report in the form and manner prescribed
10	by the service the following information for each prescribed burn
11	the CIPBM conducts:
12	(1) the amount of land burned in acres by county;
13	(2) the date of the burn; and
14	(3) whether the burn resulted in a financial loss or
15	wildfire response.
16	Sec. 2155.010. EXCESSIVE CLAIMS. If the service determines
17	that a participating CIPBM has made excessive claims under
18	self-insurance coverage under this chapter, the service may:
19	(1) terminate the CIPBM's participation in the
20	self-insurance pool under this chapter; or
21	(2) refer the CIPBM to the Prescribed Burning Board
22	for disciplinary action under Section 153.102, Natural Resources
23	Code, as if the CIPBM violated Chapter 153 of that code.
24	Sec. 2155.011. LEGAL REPRESENTATION. (a) The service may
25	employ an attorney to represent a CIPBM in a liability action for
26	which insurance coverage is provided under this chapter.
27	(b) The attorney general may not provide the services

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<u>described by Subsection (a).</u>
<u>Sec. 2155.012. EXPIRATION OF PROGRAM AND CHAPTER. The</u>
program and this chapter expire September 1, 2040. On expiration of
the program, the remaining balance in the fund that is not needed to
pay claims is transferred to the statewide fire contingency account
established under Section 88.117, Education Code.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
