16	this section, the] department shall, on receipt of a report of
17	suspected abuse or neglect, immediately notify <u>a county or</u> [the]
18	district attorney with jurisdiction to investigate or prosecute the
19	reported abuse or neglect of the report.
20	(b) On request by the county or district attorney, [as
21	requested and] the department shall forward a copy of the report of
22	abuse or neglect and all information concerning the investigation
