A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the punishment for the offense of arson involving a 3 government building. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 28.02(d), Penal Code, is amended to read 5 as follows: 6 (d) An offense under Subsection (a) is a felony of the 7 second degree, except that the offense is a felony of the first 8 degree if it is shown on the trial of the offense that: 9 (1) bodily injury or death was suffered by any person 10 11 by reason of the commission of the offense; or 12 (2) the property intended to be damaged or destroyed by the actor was a: 13 14 (A) government building; 15 (B) habitation; or (C) $[\frac{1}{2}]$ place of assembly or worship. 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 20 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 23 before that date. 24
