A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the repeal of certain provisions authorizing cemeteries 3 in certain municipalities and counties. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 711.008(a), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b), (f), (g), (g-1), 7 (g-2), [<del>(g-3), (g-4),</del>] (h), (k), and (m), an individual, 8 9 corporation, partnership, firm, trust, or association may not establish or operate a cemetery, or use any land for the interment 10 of remains, located: 11 12 (1) in or within one mile of the boundaries of a 13 municipality with a population of 5,000 to 25,000; 14 (2) in or within two miles of the boundaries of a municipality with a population of 25,000 to 50,000; 15 in or within three miles of the boundaries of a 16 (3) municipality with a population of 50,000 to 100,000; 17 in or within four miles of the boundaries of a 18 (4) municipality with a population of 100,000 to 200,000; or 19 (5) in or within five miles of the boundaries of a 20 21 municipality with a population of at least 200,000. 22 SECTION 2. Sections 711.008(g-3) and (g-4), Health and 23 Safety Code, are repealed. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 24
