1-22 relating to prohibiting the regulation of home school programs.
1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 1, Education Code, is amended by adding
1-25 Section 1.010 to read as follows:
1-26 Sec. 1.010. PROHIBITION ON REGULATION OF HOME SCHOOLS. The
1-27 Texas Education Agency, the State Board of Education, or any other
1-28 educational institution described by Section 1.001(a) may not adopt
1-29 a rule or policy that regulates an educational program of a home
1-30 school.
1-31 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
1-32 school year.
1-33 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
