- 3 vacancies on the board of commissioners of the Brazoria Drainage
- 4 District No. 4.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 7, Chapter 991, Acts of the 74th
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 1995, is amended by amending
- 8 Subsections (a) and (f) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (a) The district is managed by a board of three
- 11 commissioners as provided by Chapter 56, Water Code, and each holds
- 12 an elected office designated as Place No. 1, Place No. 2, or Place
- 13 No. 3. The board shall call and hold elections for the appropriate
- 14 number of commissioners on the uniform election date in May
- 15 [November] of each odd-numbered [even-numbered] year. The
- 16 [Notwithstanding Section 56.063, Water Code, the] commissioners
- 17 serve staggered four-year terms, each beginning June [January] 1 of
- 18 the year of [following] the commissioner's election and continuing
- 19 until the commissioner's successor in office is elected and has
- 20 qualified.
- 21 (a-1) If a commissioner announces the commissioner's
- 22 candidacy, or in fact becomes a candidate, in any general, special,
- 23 or primary election for any office of profit or trust under the laws
- 24 of this state or the United States other than the office of

- 1 commissioner for the district at any time when the unexpired term of
- 2 office of the commissioner exceeds one year and 30 days, the
- 3 announcement or candidacy constitutes an automatic resignation of
- 4 the office of the commissioner.
- 5 (f) A vacancy in a commissioner's office or other board
- 6 office shall be filled as provided by Section 49.105, Water Code [by
- 7 appointment by the remaining commissioners if less than 290 days
- 8 remain before the date of the next regular election of one or more
- 9 commissioners. If the commissioners do not agree on an appointment
- 10 before the 61st day after the date the vacancy occurs, the
- 11 commissioners shall call and hold a special election to fill the
- 12 office before the 121st day after the date the vacancy occurs].
- 13 SECTION 2. Sections 7(b), (c), (d), (e), (h), and (i),
- 14 Chapter 991, Acts of the 74th Legislature, Regular Session, 1995,
- 15 are repealed.
- 16 SECTION 3. (a) The Brazoria Drainage District No. 4 shall
- 17 hold the first election to elect commissioners for Place No. 1 and
- 18 Place No. 2 as described by Section 7(a), Chapter 991, Acts of the
- 19 74th Legislature, Regular Session, 1995, as amended by this Act, on
- 20 the uniform election date in May 2029.
- 21 (b) The Brazoria Drainage District No. 4 shall hold the
- 22 first election to elect the commissioner for Place No. 3 as
- 23 described by Section 7(a), Chapter 991, Acts of the 74th
- 24 Legislature, Regular Session, 1995, as amended by this Act, on the
- 25 uniform election date in May 2027.
- 26 (c) The terms of the commissioners for Place No. 1 and Place
- 27 No. 2 serving on the board of commissioners of the Brazoria Drainage

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- 1 District No. 4 on the effective date of this Act expire on the later
- 2 of May 31, 2029, or the date the commissioners elected under
- 3 Subsection (a) of this section have qualified.
- 4 (d) The term of the commissioner for Place No. 3 serving on
- 5 the board of commissioners of the Brazoria Drainage District No. 4
- 6 immediately before the date of the election held under Subsection
- 7 (b) of this section expires on the later of May 31, 2027, or the date
- 8 the commissioner elected under that subsection has qualified.
- 9 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 10 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 11 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 12 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 13 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 14 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 15 Government Code.
- 16 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 17 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 18 Environmental Quality.
- 19 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 20 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 21 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 22 representatives within the required time.
- 23 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 24 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 25 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 26 and accomplished.
- 27 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
