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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 418.012, Government Code, is amended to
- read as follows: 7
- (a) Under this chapter, 8 Sec. 418.012. EXECUTIVE ORDERS.
- 9 the governor may issue executive orders, proclamations,
- 10 regulations and amend or rescind them. Executive orders,
- proclamations, and regulations have the force and effect of law. 11
- 12 (b) An executive order, proclamation, or regulation issued
- by the governor under this chapter that restricts the operation of 13
- 14 or the hours of operation for a business that sells alcoholic
- beverages may not include an organization exempt from federal 15
- taxation under Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an 16
- organization described by Section 501(c)(19) of that code, that 17
- benefits veterans of the United States armed forces. This 18
- 19 subsection does not apply to an executive order, proclamation, or
- regulation issued by the governor during a natural disaster. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 418.012, Government Code, as amended by
- this Act, applies only to a declaration of a state of disaster 22
- issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A 23
- declaration issued before the effective date of this Act is 2.4

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- 1 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 2 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
