## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 662.117 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 662.117. AMERICAN PATRIOTISM MONTH. (a) July is
7	American Patriotism Month to:
8	(1) celebrate the United States of America and honor
9	the values and principles on which it was founded; and
10	(2) recognize:
11	(A) the brave patriots who fought for the right
12	of self-governance in the American War of Independence and those
13	who volunteered to serve this country in every conflict fought
14	since the founding of this country;
15	(B) the founding fathers of the United States of
16	America and the framers of the Constitution;
17	(C) the astronauts who won the space race and
18	walked on the moon, and the people who supported them;
19	(D) the civil rights leaders and activists who
20	risked their lives to fight for equal rights for all Americans; and
21	(E) the resilience, patriotism, and unity shown
22	by the American people after the September 11, 2001, terror
23	attacks.
24	(b) American Patriotism Month shall be regularly observed

- 2 <u>a sense of national pride and national identity.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
