- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 285.001(a) and (b), Transportation
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) To promote the public safety, the commissioners court of
- 8 a county with a population of more than 500,000 [1.3 million] by
- 9 order may regulate the following in the unincorporated area of the
- 10 county if they occur on a public highway or road, in the
- 11 right-of-way of a public highway or road, or in a parking lot:
- 12 (1) the sale of items by a vendor of food or
- 13 merchandise, including live animals;
- 14 (2) the erection, maintenance, or placement of a
- 15 structure by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live
- 16 animals; and
- 17 (3) the solicitation of money.
- 18 (b) The commissioners court of a county with a population of
- 19 more than 200,000 [870,000] that borders the United Mexican States
- 20 by order may regulate the activities described by Subsection (a) in
- 21 the manner described by that subsection, except that [+
- [(1) the regulation of activities on or in the
- 23 right-of-way of a public highway or road is limited to public
- 24 highways and roads with a speed limit of 40 miles per hour or

- 2 $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ the county may not prohibit the sale of
- 3 livestock.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
