- 1 (c) A property owner that pays an amount of taxes greater than that required by Subsection (b) does not forfeit the property 2 owner's right to a final determination of the appeal by making the 3 payment. The property owner may pay an additional amount of taxes 4 5 at any time. If the property owner files a timely appeal under this chapter, taxes paid on the property are considered paid under 6 protest, even if paid before the appeal is filed. If the taxes are 7 8 subject to the split-payment option provided by Section 31.03, the property owner may comply with Subsection (b) of this section by 9 paying one-half of the amount otherwise required to be paid under 10 that subsection before December 1 or, if applicable, the date 11 provided by Section 31.03(a-1) and paying the remaining one-half of 12 that amount before July 1 of the following year. 13
