1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to a public school policy for establishing age for
1-22 purposes of admission into the school for certain children of
1-23 foreign military members.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 25.001, Education Code, is amended by
1-26 adding Subsection (c-3) to read as follows:

1-27 (c-3) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (b), the board of
1-28 trustees of a school district may adopt a policy to allow a person
1-29 whose parent or guardian is an active-duty member of a foreign
1-30 military force stationed in this state to establish the person's
1-31 age for purposes of determining eligibility under those subsections
1-32 by demonstrating that the person will turn the required age during
1-33 the school year for which the person is seeking admission.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
1-35 school year.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
