BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 25.001, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c-3) to read as follows: 1-25 1-26

1-27 1-28 (c-3) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (b), the board of trustees of a school district may adopt a policy to allow a person whose parent or guardian is an active-duty member of a foreign 1-29 1-30 military force stationed in this state to establish the person's age for purposes of determining eligibility under those subsections 1-31 by demonstrating that the person will turn the required age during the school year for which the person is seeking admission. 1-32 1-33

SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026 1-34 1-35 school year.

1-36 $\bar{\texttt{SECTION}}$ 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-37 1-38 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 1-40
