- 5 SECTION 1. Section 20A.02, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) This subsection applies only to a prosecution for an
- 8 offense under Subsection (a)(7) or (8), in which the actor is
- 9 alleged to have caused a trafficked child or disabled individual to
- 10 engage in or become the victim of prostitution, as defined by
- 11 Section 43.01. It is not a defense to a prosecution described by
- 12 this subsection that the trafficked child or disabled individual:
- 13 (1) lacks the culpable mental state to engage in the
- 14 act of prostitution; or
- 15 (2) did not complete the act of prostitution.
- SECTION 2. Section 20A.03, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 17 Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- (f) This subsection applies only to a prosecution for an
- 19 offense under this section based on conduct constituting an offense
- 20 under Section 20A.02(a)(7) or (8), in which the actor is alleged to
- 21 have caused for one or more times a trafficked child or disabled
- 22 individual to engage in or become the victim of prostitution as
- 23 <u>defined by Section 43.01</u>. It is not a defense to a prosecution
- 24 described by this subsection that the trafficked child or disabled

- 1 <u>individual:</u>
- 2 (1) lacks the culpable mental state to engage in the
- 3 act of prostitution; or
- 4 (2) did not complete the act of prostitution.
- 5 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 7 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 8 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 9 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 10 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 11 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 12 committed before that date.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
