- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.04(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (a) A person who has been convicted of a felony offense
- 8 listed in Article 42A.054(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, commits
- 9 an offense if the person [he] possesses a firearm:
- 10 (1) after conviction and before the fifth anniversary
- 11 of the person's release from confinement following conviction of
- 12 the felony offense or the person's release from supervision under
- 13 community supervision, parole, or mandatory supervision, whichever
- 14 date is later; or
- 15 (2) after the period described by Subdivision (1), at
- 16 any location other than the premises at which the person lives.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 18 46.04(a), Penal Code, applies to an offense committed before, on,
- 19 or after the effective date of this Act. However, a final
- 20 conviction for an offense that exists on the effective date of this
- 21 Act remains unaffected by this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
