- 2 relating to criminal offenses for creating and distributing certain
- 3 misleading images and videos; creating a criminal offense.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 255.004, Election Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 255.004. FALSE IMAGES, VIDEOS, AND SOURCES [TRUE
- 8 SOURCE] OF COMMUNICATION.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 255.004, Election Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsections (c), (d), and (e) and adding Subsections (d-1)
- 11 and (d-2) to read as follows:
- 12 (c) An offense under <u>Subsection (a)</u>, (b), or (d) [this
- 13 section] is a Class A misdemeanor. An offense under Subsection
- 14 (d-1) is a Class B misdemeanor.
- 15 (d) A person commits an offense if the person, with the
- 16 intent to deceive and with the intent to injure a candidate or
- 17 influence the result of an election:
- 18 (1) creates or causes to be created a deep fake video;
- 19 and
- 20 (2) <u>publishes</u>, <u>distributes</u>, <u>or</u> causes [the deep fake
- 21 video] to be published or distributed the deep fake video [within 30
- 22 days of an election].
- 23 (d-1) A person commits an offense if the person, with the
- 24 intent to deceive and influence the result of an election:

- 1 (1) creates or causes to be created an altered image;
- 2 and
- 3 (2) publishes, distributes, or causes to be published
- 4 or distributed the altered image.
- 5 (d-2) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution for an
- 6 offense under Subsection (d-1) if the person includes on the image a
- 7 <u>clear label stating that the image is altered.</u>
- 8 (e) In this section:[____]
- 9 (1) "Altered image" means an image that has been
- 10 manipulated to change the physical appearance of an individual or
- 11 depict an individual performing an action that did not occur. The
- 12 term does not include:
- (A) a cartoon, caricature, or any other image
- 14 that a reasonable viewer would understand to be a satirical
- 15 representation of the individual; or
- 16 (B) an image altered only to change the
- 17 saturation, brightness, contrast, color, or any other superficial
- 18 quality of the image.
- 19 (2) "Deep ["deep] fake video" means a video[, created
- 20 with the intent to deceive, that appears to depict a real person
- 21 performing an action that did not occur in reality.
- 22 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 24 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 25 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 26 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 27 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

- 1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 2 before that date.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
