1 AN ACT 2 relating to policies on the recess period in public schools. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is 4 5 amended by adding Sections 28.0045 and 28.0046 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 28.0045. MODEL RECESS POLICIES. The Department of 7 State Health Services School Health Advisory Committee established under Section 1001.0711, Health and Safety Code, shall develop 8 9 model policies for the recess period during the school day that encourage constructive, age-appropriate outdoor playtime. 10 The model policies must include guidelines for outdoor equipment and 11 facilities on public school campuses that maximize 12 the effectiveness of outdoor physical activity. 13 Sec. 28.0046. RECESS POLICY. (a) The board of trustees of 14 each school district shall: 15 (1) after reviewing the model recess policies 16 developed under Section 28.0045 and the policy recommendations of 17 the local school health advisory council provided under Section 18 28.004(1), adopt a recess policy based on those model policies and 19 20 recommendations; and 21 (2) review and, if necessary, revise the recess policy 22 at least every five years. 23 (b) The recess policy must specify: 24 (1) the required number of minutes of weekly

1 unstructured playtime; and

2 (2) whether a student's recess time may be withheld as
3 a form of student discipline.

4 (c) Each school district campus subject to the district
5 recess policy adopted under Subsection (a) shall implement the
6 recess policy.

7 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2026, the 8 Department of State Health Services School Health Advisory 9 Committee shall develop model recess policies as required by 10 Section 28.0045, Education Code, as added by this Act.

(b) Not later than May 1, 2026, the board of trustees of each school district shall adopt a recess policy as required by Section 28.0046, Education Code, as added by this Act.

14 (c) Not later than the beginning of the 2026-2027 school 15 year, each school district campus subject to a school district 16 recess policy adopted under Section 28.0046, Education Code, as 17 added by this Act, shall implement the adopted policy.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
