11	operated through The University of Texas System, must include
12	applications for nursing schools in this state.
13	(b) The governing board of The University of Texas System
14	shall establish an advisory board to develop:
15	(1) recommendations for including applications for
16	nursing schools in this state in the consolidated application
17	services for applications to medical schools or dental schools as
18	required under Subsection (a); and

- 12 System shall appoint the members of the advisory board under
- 13 Section 51.765(c), Education Code, as added by this Act, not later
- 14 than November 1, 2025.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
