A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to student union building fees at The University of Texas 3 at El Paso.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 54.535, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1), (a-2), and 7 (a-3) to read as follows:

The board of regents of The University of Texas System 8 (a) 9 may levy a student union fee in an amount not to exceed \$150 [\$30] per student for each <u>semester or term of 10</u> [regular semester or 10 11 each summer session of six] weeks or more, and not to exceed \$75 12 [\$15] per student for any other semester or term [each summer session of less than six weeks], for the sole purpose of financing, 13 constructing, operating, maintaining, and improving a student 14 union building for The University of Texas at El Paso, including 15 16 demolition of the existing student union building; provided, however, that the fee may not be increased to an amount that exceeds 17 by at least 10 percent the amount of the fee levied during the 18 preceding academic year, [above \$15 per student for each regular 19 semester or each summer session of six weeks or more and \$7.50 per 20 21 student for each summer session of less than six weeks] unless the increase is approved by a majority vote of [those] students 22 23 enrolled at the university participating in a general student election held for that purpose. 3	(a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for a semester or
4	term before the 2026 fall semester, the amount of a fee levied under
5	this section may not exceed:
6	(1) \$70 per student for a semester or term of 10 weeks
7	<u>or more; or</u>
8	(2) \$35 per student for a semester or term not
9	described by Subdivision (1).
10	(a-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for a semester or
11	term of the 2026-2027 academic year, the amount of a fee levied
12	under this section may not exceed:

17	(a-3) Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) and this subsection

19	SECTION 2. Section 54.535, Education Code, as amended by
