A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the replacement and modernization of obsolete and
- 3 inefficient computer hardware and software technology used by
- 4 certain state agencies.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2054.092(b), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The plan must:
- 9 (1) provide a strategic direction for information
- 10 resources management in state government for the five fiscal years
- 11 following adoption of the plan;
- 12 (2) outline a state information architecture that
- 13 contains a logically consistent set of principles, policies, and
- 14 standards to guide the engineering of state government's
- 15 information technology systems and infrastructure in a way that
- 16 ensures compatibility and alignment with state government's needs;
- 17 (3) designate and report on critical electronic
- 18 government projects to be directed by the department, including a
- 19 project for electronic purchasing;
- 20 (4) provide information about best practices to assist
- 21 state agencies in adopting effective information management
- 22 methods, including the design, deployment, and management of
- 23 information resources projects, cost-benefit analyses, and staff
- 24 reengineering methods to take full advantage of technological

- 1 advancements;
- 2 (5) provide long-range policy guidelines for
- 3 information resources in state government, including the
- 4 implementation of national, international, and department
- 5 standards for information resources technologies;
- 6 (6) identify major issues faced by state agencies
- 7 related to the acquisition of computer hardware, computer software,
- 8 and information resources technology services and develop a
- 9 statewide approach to address the issues, including:
- 10 (A) developing performance measures for
- 11 purchasing and contracting; and
- 12 (B) identifying opportunities to reuse computer
- 13 software code purchased with public funds;
- 14 (7) identify priorities for:
- 15 (A) the implementation of information resources
- 16 technologies according to the relative economic and social impact
- 17 on the state; and
- 18 (B) return on investment and cost-benefit
- 19 analysis strategies; [and]
- 20 (8) outline a statewide legacy system modernization
- 21 strategy based on information submitted under Section 2054.5725 to
- 22 <u>increase government efficiency through technology modernization;</u>
- 23 and
- 24 (9) provide information about best practices to assist
- 25 state agencies in adopting methods for design, deployment, and
- 26 management of telecommunications services.
- 27 SECTION 2. Subchapter Q, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is

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- 1 amended by adding Section 2054.5725 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 2054.5725. LEGACY SYSTEM MODERNIZATION PLAN. (a)
- 3 Each state agency shall identify legacy systems used by the agency
- 4 and create a plan to replace those systems with systems that provide
- 5 <u>a more modern, integrated, secure, and effective technological</u>
- 6 <u>environment</u>.
- 7 (b) Not later than September 1 of each odd-numbered year, a
- 8 state agency shall submit the plan required by this section to the
- 9 department.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
